

Meeting Venue & Entrances

University of Vienna, Pharma Centre, Department of Pharmacognosy, room 2D404, Althanstrasse 14, A-1090 Vienna, Austria.

- Side entrance Rotunde (from Liechtenwerder Platz)
- Side entrance Geozentrum (from Althanstraße)
- Back entrance (from Nordbergstraße 17)

Arrival by Public Transport

Tram D:

Get off at *Liechtenwerder Platz* and take your route across *Josef-Holaubek-Platz* (between the *Verkehrsamt* and the *UZA 2*), reaching the stairs up to the University grounds. Following the *UZA 2* sign on the ground turn to the left and enter the building labelled *Rotunde*.

Underground U4 or U6:

Getting off at station *Spittelau*, follow the sign *Verkehrsamt*. You walk along the *Verkehrsamt* and then have to edge to the right. Cross the road at the *Josef-Holaubek-Platz* using the crosswalk which again leads to the stairs and to the side entrance *Rotunde* as described above.

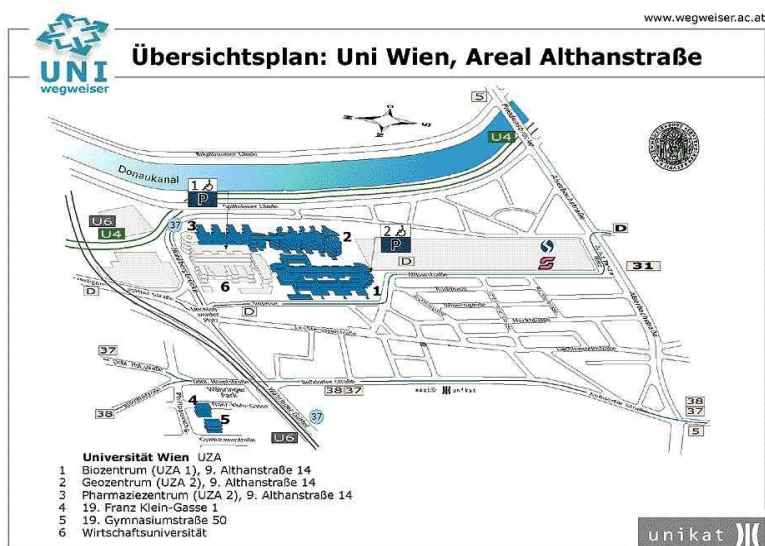
Bus 35 A:

This bus stops at the *Josef-Holaubek-Platz*. You may use the same route as described before.

Arrival by Car

Please make sure to use *Liechtenwerder Platz* as your arrival street. Thus you will be able to use the parking garage underneath the *Wirtschaftsuniversität*.

You can leave the parking garage at *Josef-Holaubek-Platz* using the same route as described above. There are also several possibilities to enter the *UZA 2* from the inside of the parking garage.
